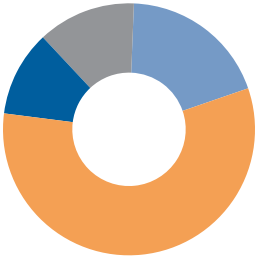

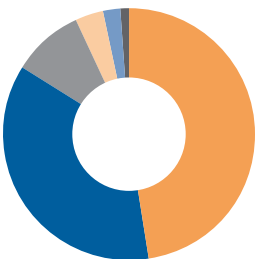
# 2025 REVENUE & EXPENSES

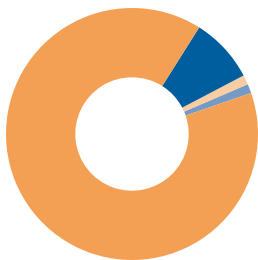

## Legacy in Action

After losing her husband, a Fresno widow sought guidance from a godly financial advisor to steward what they had built. Through prayerful conversations, she chose to establish a Donor-Advised Fund with Ten Talents Foundation. When asked to name a successor advisor, she chose her granddaughter as an additional adviser, so as she grows older, her values and giving continue. This is legacy giving, not just transferring wealth, but passing on a heart of generosity to the next generation.

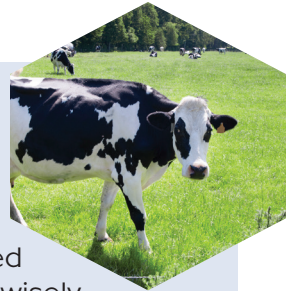

## Provision to Purpose

Near year end, a generous farm family felt prompted to give. Not cash, but cattle. Working alongside their CPA, the gift was structured through Ten Talents Donor-Advised Funds to accept and distribute the donation wisely.

One hundred and five calves were transferred to our buyer and sold within just 5 days. Releasing \$249,000 for ministry with no income or tax liability to the businesses.

Within weeks, those funds were already at work. Distributed to local churches, ministries, and Christian education partners advancing the Gospel. What started as livestock became immediate Kingdom impact.
